Thank you for using our company multimedia player . To operate the unit correctly , please read the operation manual carefully before using . Keep this operation manual for further reference.

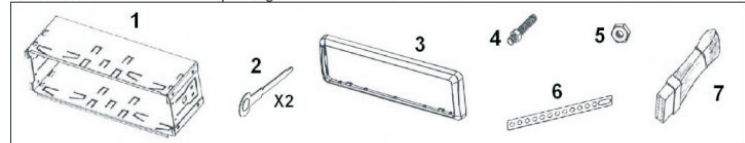
The unit is designed only for DC 12V negative ground operation system. Make sure your vehicle is connected to DC 12V negative ground electrical system. Be sure to connect the speaker(-)leads to the speaker(-) terminal. Never connect the left and right channel speaker wires together or to the vehicle body.

The normal temperature for operation is between -20 and +60 degree Celsius. Do not work in extreme high or low temperature and block vents radiator panels of the unit ,blocking them will cause heat to build up inside the unit and may cause damage or fire .

This unit can play the following discs(12 cm)and media files: DVD/MP3/WMA/CDR/RW/JPEG

Mounting Method A

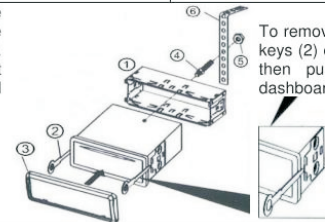
Put the mounting sleeve (1) into the dashboard.



Band the tabs of the mounting sleeve (1) outward into the dashboard for a secure mounting.



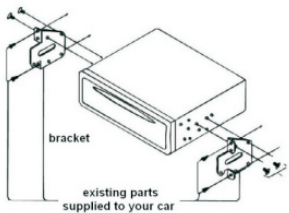
If necessary, use the strap (6) to secure the back of the unit in place. The strap (6) can be bent by hand to the desired angle.



To remove the unit, insert the release keys (2) on both sides of the unit and then pull the unit out from the dashboard.

Mounting Method B

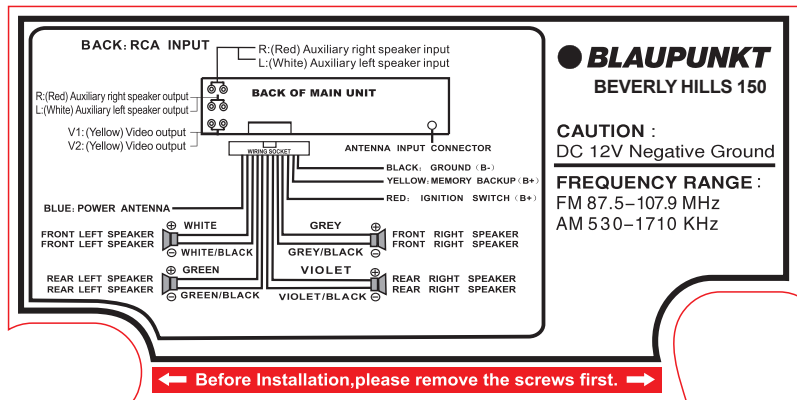
This mounting method is used for most Japanese cars. The actual mounting method should depend on the type of cars and the supplied parts.

SIMPLE TROUBLE SHOOTING

PROBLEMS, CAUSES & SOLUTIONS
<p>No power</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Check and make sure the connecting wires are connected correctly - Check whether the fuse is blown. Replace with the proper value fuse if necessary.
<p>No sound</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Check and make sure the speaker wires are connected correctly.
<p>No picture</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Check whether the video wire is connected to the video device.
<p>Unit hang-up</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Press the RESET button to reset the unit to its default stage.
<p>No function when pressing the buttons</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Press the RESET button to reset the unit to its default stage.
<p>Poor effect or unable to receive radio</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Check whether the radio antenna is inserted or properly connected. - Antenna may not be the proper length. Make sure the antenna is fully extended. - Antenna may be poorly grounded. Check and make sure the antenna is properly grounded.
<p>Stereo cannot be received under radio mode</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Tune the radio frequency accurately. - The broadcasting signal is too weak, set the mode to MONO.
<p>Disc inserted but cannot play</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Check whether the disc inserted upside down. - Check whether the disc is dirty or badly cracked. - Lens is dirty. Clean lens by using the lens clean disc.
<p>Abnormal moving, skipping or sound during playback</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The disc is dirty or damaged. Wipe the disc with a dry soft cloth or replace a new disc.
<p>Remote handset does not work</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Replace new battery of the remote handset. - Point the remote handset directly at the remote sensor of the main unit. - Clean the surface of the remote sensor.
<p>Bluetooth not operated</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - check the devices are linked up correctly.

DISC SLOT Insert or remove disc from this disc slot

 **Disc Input Mode** Press to eject disc from the disc slot

 When the unit is turn off, press to turn on the unit.
When the unit is turn on, press & hold shortly to turn off the unit.

 **Bluetooth Mode** (when a mobile phone connected Press to hang up or refuse an incoming call.
SRC when the unit is turned on, press repeatedly to select desired mode for operation.

BND or BAND  **Radio Mode** Press repeatedly to select the desired radio band for broadcasting
Bluetooth Mode (when a mobile phone connected) When an incoming call received, press to pick up the call. Press to dial out after input a phone number. Press to redial the last call.

Press to detach the front panel from the main unit

PAUSE/PLAY/KEY NUMBER 1

Press the pause/Play button to pause, play, or resume audio playback.

Turning the volume knob will also resume playback.

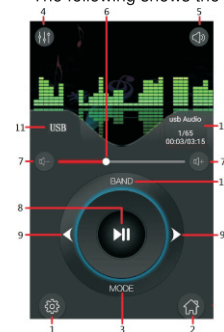

~ The following menu appeared in the mobile phone and you can start control the car unit with this menu (Bluetooth must be connected):





~ The following shows the control option:



1. Shift to setting menu for Bluetooth set up. (Note: it is a must to select and connect to the car unit in order to have control)
2. Exit the application.
3. Selection of operation mode.
4. Shift to set for the output level on bass / treble / balance / fader.
5. Turn on/off of sound mute control.
6. Slide to set for sound output level.
7. Set for sound output level.
8. Playback & pause control.
9. Shift track/channel up/down for playback/broadcasting.
10. Radio band selection.
11. This shows the operating mode.

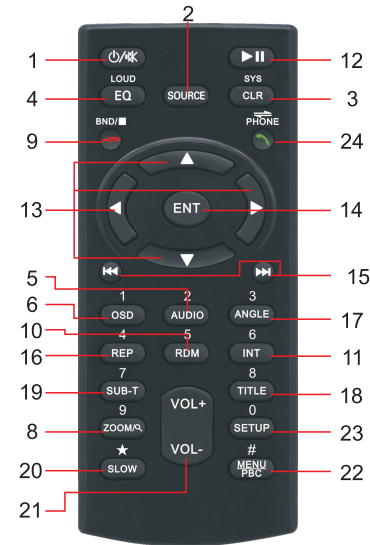
